

The Giuliano Mazzuoli Cellini Manometro Gold Edition

Famed Italian designer and watchmaker Giuliano Mazzuoli has added another model to his repertoire of avant-garde and artistic timepieces. Developed in collaboration with Leon Adams of Manhattan's prestigious Cellini Jewelers, Mazzuoli introduces a gold variation of the Manometro Sport. Constructed in the signature proportions of 45.2 mm by 14.8 mm, the cylindrical case is designed in an amalgam of 18-karat rose gold (available in both brushed and polished) and carbon fiber, and is available exclusively at Cellini Jewelers in New York City.

As with the original Manometro, this version of the Manometro Sport operates by means of an ETA 2824/2 automatic movement, with Incabloc protection and *côtes de Geneve* finishing. The graphically designed carbon fiber dial prominently displays the hours, minutes, seconds and date, each of which is set by the uniquely positioned gold crown at the 2 o'clock marker. A sleek red rubber ring encircles the crown, accentuating the red detailing upon the dial and seconds hand. A black rubber strap affixes the Manometro Sport to the wrist, as the sporty nature of Giuliano Mazzuoli's acclaimed collection is altogether reaffirmed by this model.
