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1 OMEGA SPEEDMASTER PROFESSIONAL

The first watch on the Moon is also a pretty serious racing timepiece, being an officially certified Swiss chronometer. A tachymeter dial around the outside enables you to calculate vehicle speeds by timing them over a fixed distance. £1,675, mappin-and-webb.co.uk

2 GIULIANO MAZZUOLI MANOMETRO S

This pressure gauge-styled, carbon-fibre watch, available in left- and right-handed versions, was designed by Italian ex-racing driver Giuliano Mazzuoli. His similar Contagiri model matches the rev counter on an Alfa 8C Competizione. £2,500, giulianomazzuoli.com

3 CHOPARD MILLE MIGLIA GT XL POWER CONTROL

Named after the famous Italian road race, this huge (44mm) limited-edition chronograph has a power-reserve dial in the style of a petrol gauge. To add even more racing credibility, the strap is made from a Sixties Dunlop racing tyre. £2,755, chopard.com

4 TAG HEUER GRAND CARRERA CALIBRE 17R

From Steve McQueen to Lewis Hamilton, TAGs have been the racer's first choice. On the latest model, the hands of the chronograph have been replaced by two revolving discs - making it easier to read when hot-lapping the Nürburgring. £2,995, stockist.0800.037.9658
