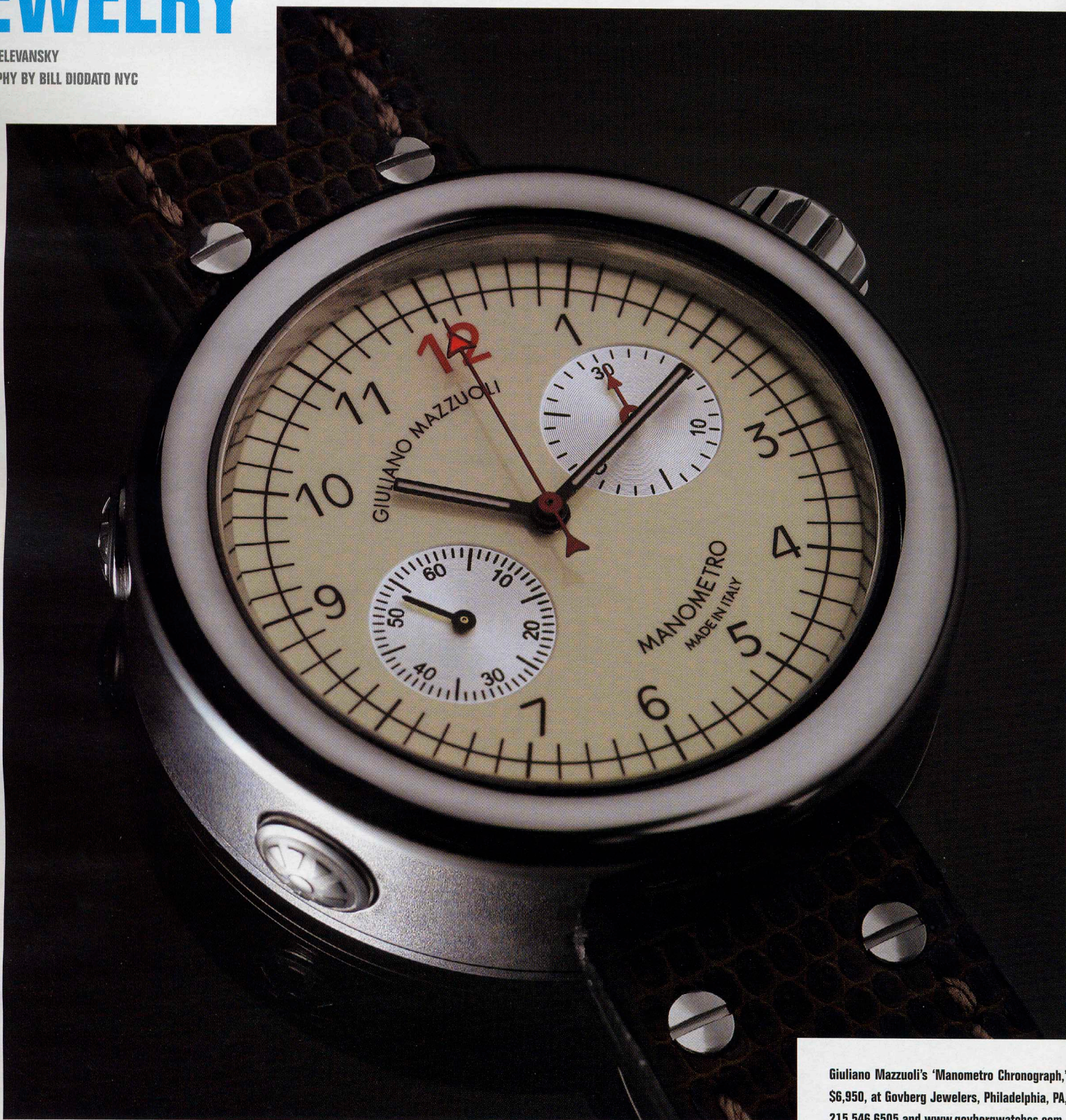

His latest creation, the 'Manometro Chronograph,' is a timepiece inspired by the classic pressure gauge. With black or ivory dials and consciously cultivated idiosyncrasies like uniquely positioned brushed silver subdials at 2 and 8 o'clock, the Chronograph's oversized dimensions are perfect for the big time. Style and rarity (only a modest number of watches reach the U.S.) combine to attract fashion gurus like Roberto Cavalli, as well as Agnelli heir Lapo Elkann and Ferrari Formula 1 team boss Jean Todt. ■
